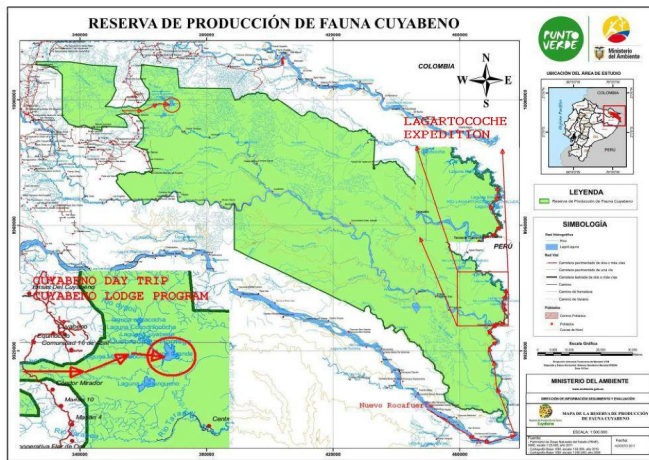


LAGARTO COCHA EXPEDITION

The Lagarto Cocha border River between Ecuador - Peru accesses an immense network of lakes, rivers, marshes and swamps in the tri-national protected areas system of Ecuador, Peru and Colombia, protecting about 1,5 million hectares of mostly virgin Amazon forest. It is the most remote corner of Ecuador's Amazon and no other operators organize tours there. The conditions are extremely primitive. Sleeping is in a house of a 7 family Siona village just across the border in Peru (no passport needed). They are the only people in the region.

Teeming with wildlife: Watching monkeys

- Day 1 Flight or bus to Coca (not included)
Transfer airport / bus station to river harbor
Coca Nuevarocafuerte speedboat
Hostal Chimborazo in Nuevarocafuerte
- Day 2 In the morning: visit Jatun Cocha in Yasuni National Park
In the afternoon: Travel in motorized canoe to Lagarto Cocha (3.5 hours) on the Aguarico
Excursion along the Lagarto Cocha river
Sleep in community facility at Lagarto Cocha (extremely primitive)
- Day 3 Explore lakes and marshes at Lagarto Cocha
Sleep at community facility
- Day 4 Explore lakes and marshes at Lagarto Cocha
Sleep at community facility
- Day 5 Morning excursion at Lagarto Cocha
Afternoon return to Nuevarocafuerte
- Day 6 Sleep at the Chimborazo Hostal
Morning speedboat Nuevarocafuerte - Coca
Transfer to hotel in Coca
Hotel en Coca
- Day 7 Transfer hotel airport / bus station
Flight or bus to Quito (not included)

Minimum number of passengers 2; Price \$990 PP. Reductions for a larger group.
